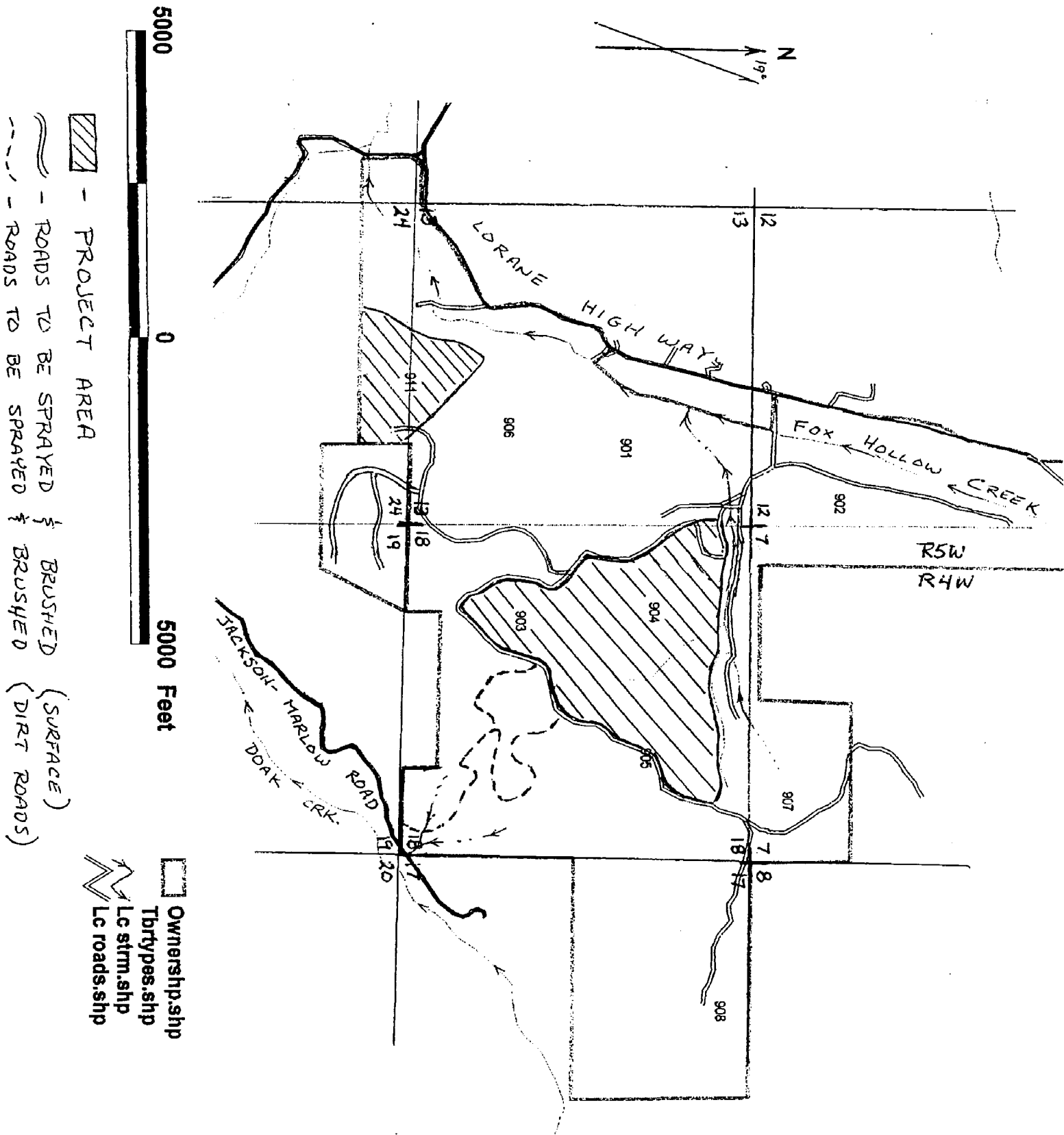

This project combines Hack & Squirt treatment of maple, Foliar treatment of Scotchbroom, and Road-side maintenance spraying. Protected resources covered by this written plan are two Small F streams, Preacher Creek and an unnamed tributary of Doak Creek.

Resource protection measures planned are as follows:

- 1) All mixing and batching operations shall be conducted at sites over 100 feet from any fish bearing stream.
- 2) No chemical application shall take place within 10 feet of the aquatic area of the Fish streams.
- 3) All application shall be done in accordance with product label requirements.
- 4) Water for chemical mixing may be taken from the Small or Medium Fish streams. This activity shall be conducted in accordance with water quality protection rules of the Forest Practices Act. A separate volume pump and system used for water only shall be used to fill the batch tanks. An air gap between the water source and mixing tank shall be maintained during the filling process.
