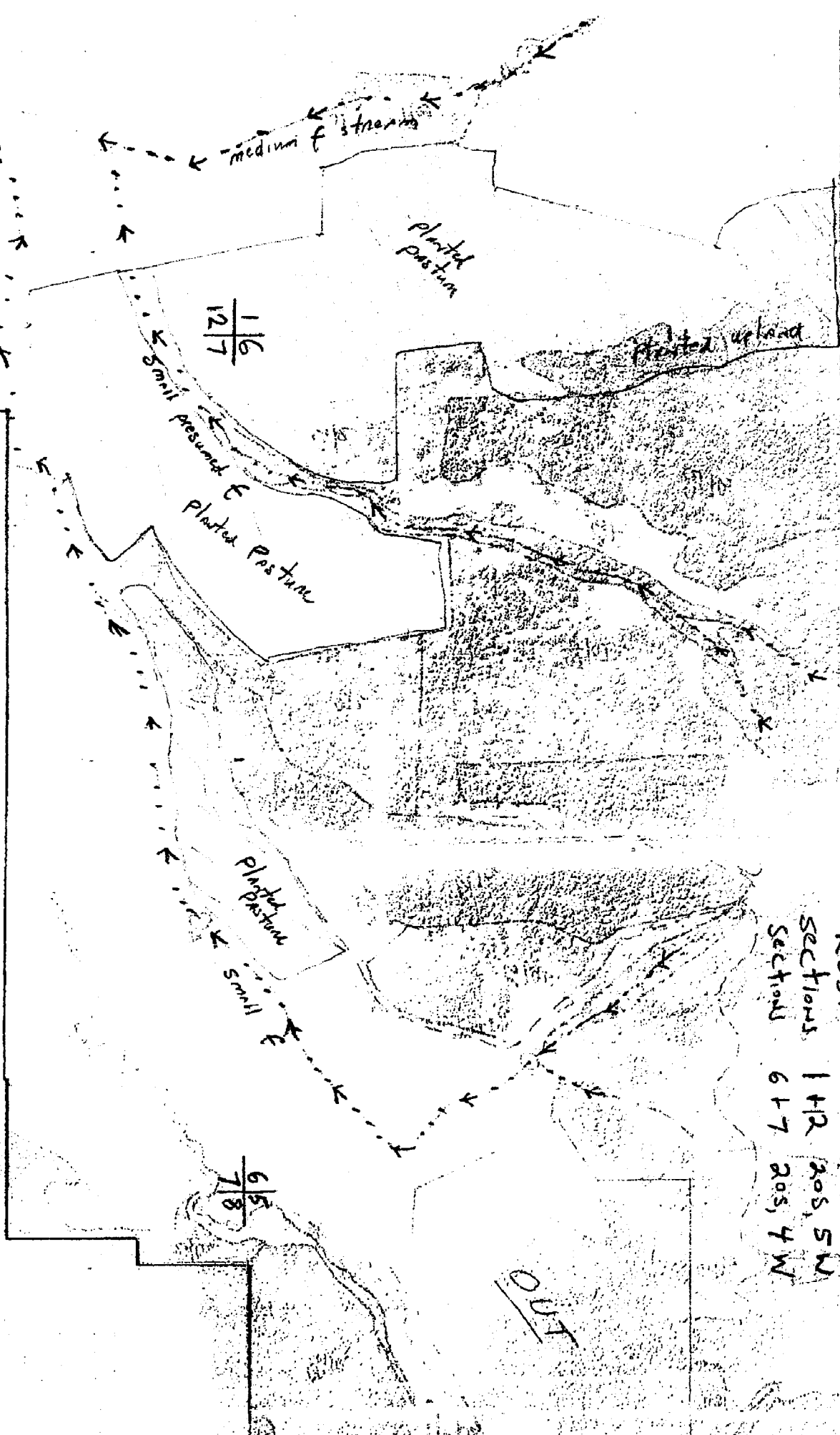

Written Plan for Aerial Herbicide Application

Protected Resource: Hawley Creek Tributaries, small streams, assumed to have fish.

Location: Kester Ranch, Section 1 & 12 T20S, R5W & Sections 6 & 7 20S, R4W

I'm writing with regard to our plan to apply grass control herbicides on planted pastureland adjacent to the small, assumed fishbearing streams referenced above.


1.5 pounds per acre of Westar herbicide will be applied by helicopter for control of grass according to EPA label requirements.

In the aerial application, all streams will have a flagged, 50 foot buffer that will not be sprayed. The helicopter will fly parallel to the streams when applying alongside buffer strips.

On the day of the application, air temperature, relative humidity and wind velocity and direction will be measured and recorded before start of the operation and hourly until completion. All EPA and ODF requirements for wind, temperature and humidity limits will be followed.

Please let me know if we need to take any other precautions.
