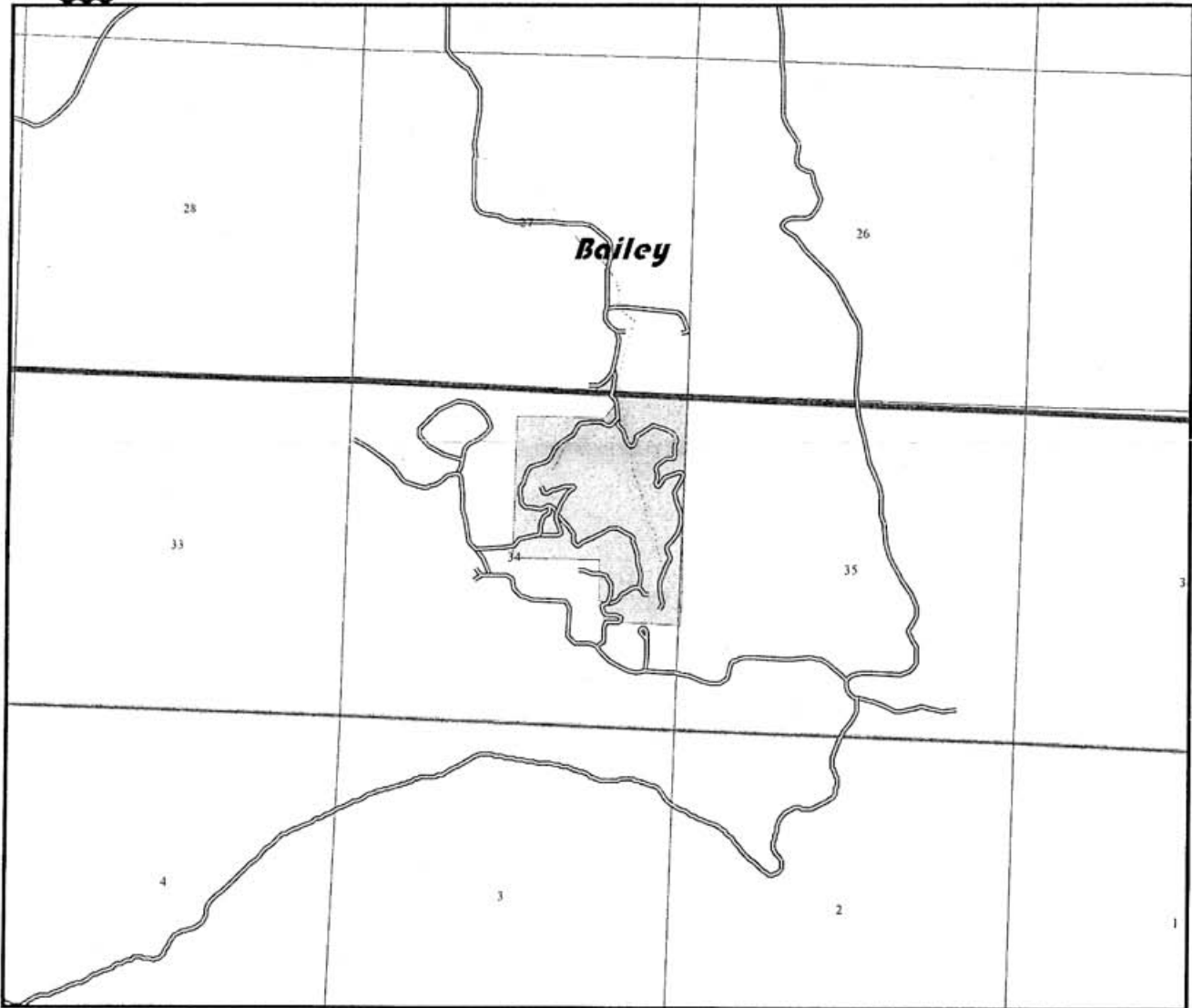

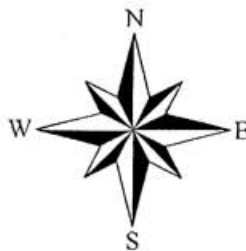

Written Plan

AREA: Bailey Tract

LANDOWNER: Plum Creek Timberlands, L.P.

OPERATOR: Plum Creek

PLANNED OPERATION: We will use an Integrated Pest Management regime to remove Scotch Broom from Plum Creek Property. Spot treatments will include pulling, cutting and herbicide spraying of the target vegetation and will occur sometime between May 15th and Dec. 31st, 2008. Our goal is to eliminate scotch broom as a threat to the native biodiversity and health of our forest ecosystems. Plum Creek will ensure that the specifications set forth in this written plan are followed as well as all regulations included on the chemical labels. Most, if not all of the work will be performed by our own professional, licensed staff of Plum Creek Resource Foresters.

TARGET VEGETATION: Scotch Broom

PROTECTED RESOURCES: All live water, including fish streams and/or domestic water systems

PROTECTION MEASURES: The following measures will be taken to protect the resources mentioned above.

1. Herbicide spraying will not be performed if wind direction or velocity is such that protected water resources are in danger of contamination.
2. All operations will be performed in accordance with the Oregon Forest Practices Act as they relate to the use and handling of chemicals.
3. We will exceed the State's 10 foot buffer requirement for spraying near Type F and Type D streams, significant wetlands, and lakes or areas with standing water larger than ¼ acre. We will use alternative methods such as pulling or cutting inside the 10 foot buffer.
