WRITTEN PLAN OF OPERATION FOR AERIAL SPRAYING

- LAND OWNER: Giustina Land & Timber Co.
- OPERATOR: Western Helicopter Services, Inc.
- LEGAL DESCRIPTION: 20S-4W-8 & 17
- UNIT NAME: Get Wise
- PROTECTED RESOURCE: Norris Creek

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: An aerial herbicide application will be conducted to suppress and/or eliminate vegetation that will hinder the establishment of conifer regeneration. The unit will be sprayed with one or more herbicides (listed on the attached notification) mixed with water as the carrier and applied at a rate of 10 gal. / acre.

PROTECTION MEASURES: Norris Creek will be buffered by leaving a minimum of 60 feet of unsprayed vegetation. The helicopter pilot will be briefed on the treatment of this area through a combination of maps, aerial photos and a reconnaissance flight prior to the herbicide application. All chemical batch activities will take place 100 feet or more from any protected waterways.

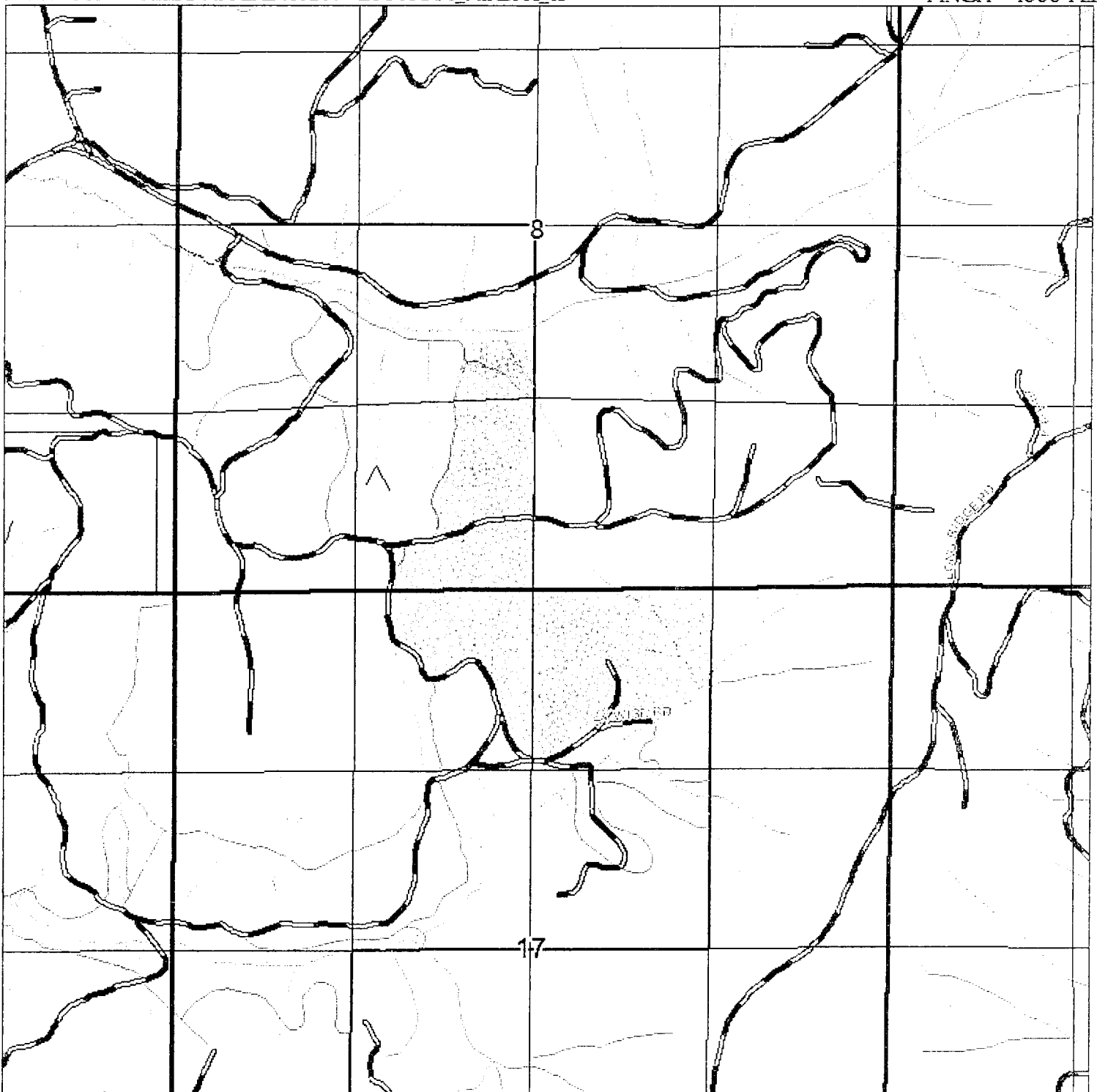

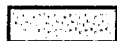
