The notified operation is located within 1/2 mile (approximately 2170 feet) of critical wildlife habitat for the Northern Spotted Owl (Doe Hollow Alt B Site). The nest site is located on land managed by the Bureau of Land Management. The operation is greater than 1/4 mile from the nest site. Therefore, the current proposed operation (aerial and ground spray) is not likely to constitute a disturbance with the site for purposes of Forest Practices Rules.
