Reviews roadside vegetation management needs and related issues and makes recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners. Works with Public Works staff to establish roadside vegetation management priorities in keeping with available funds and IVM methodologies. Reviews requests for vegetation management activities beyond the scope of routine maintenance. Reviews the program standards and policies, including long-range planning for future program needs and prepares recommendations for Board action as necessary. Serves as liaison group in representing the roadside vegetation management concerns of the community to the Board and representing Board decisions to the community.
