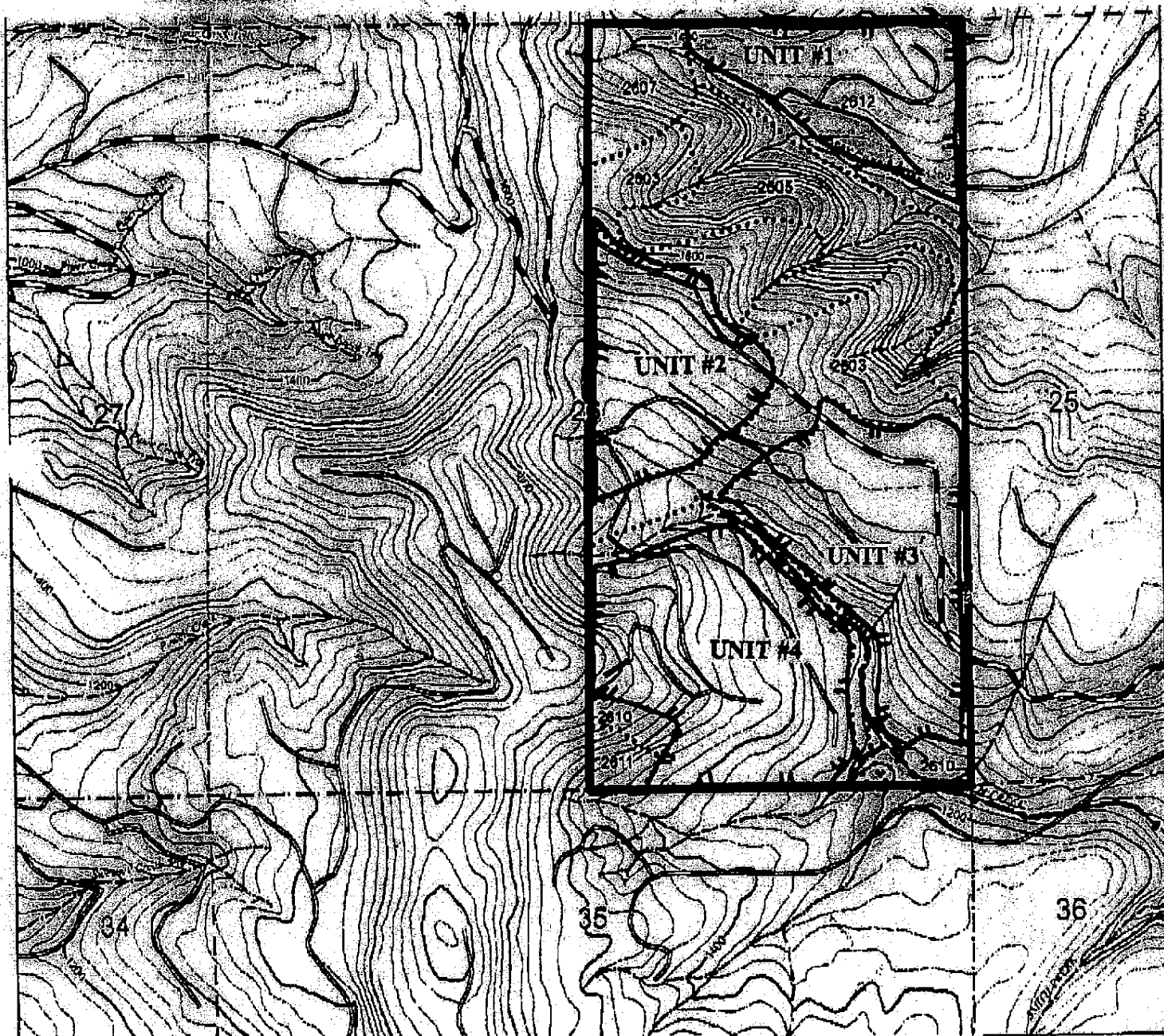

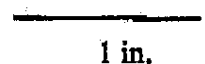
Area to be treated
