- Within 300 feet of a wildlife resource site listed in the 1994 ODF/ODFW Cooperative Agreement. (OAR 629-605-170(1)(b))

- Within 300 feet of any resource identified in the Divisions 645 or 665 of the administrative rules. (OAR 629-605-170(1)(c))

- Within 300 feet of a state or federally listed threatened or endangered wildlife resource site. (OAR 629-605-170(1)(d))

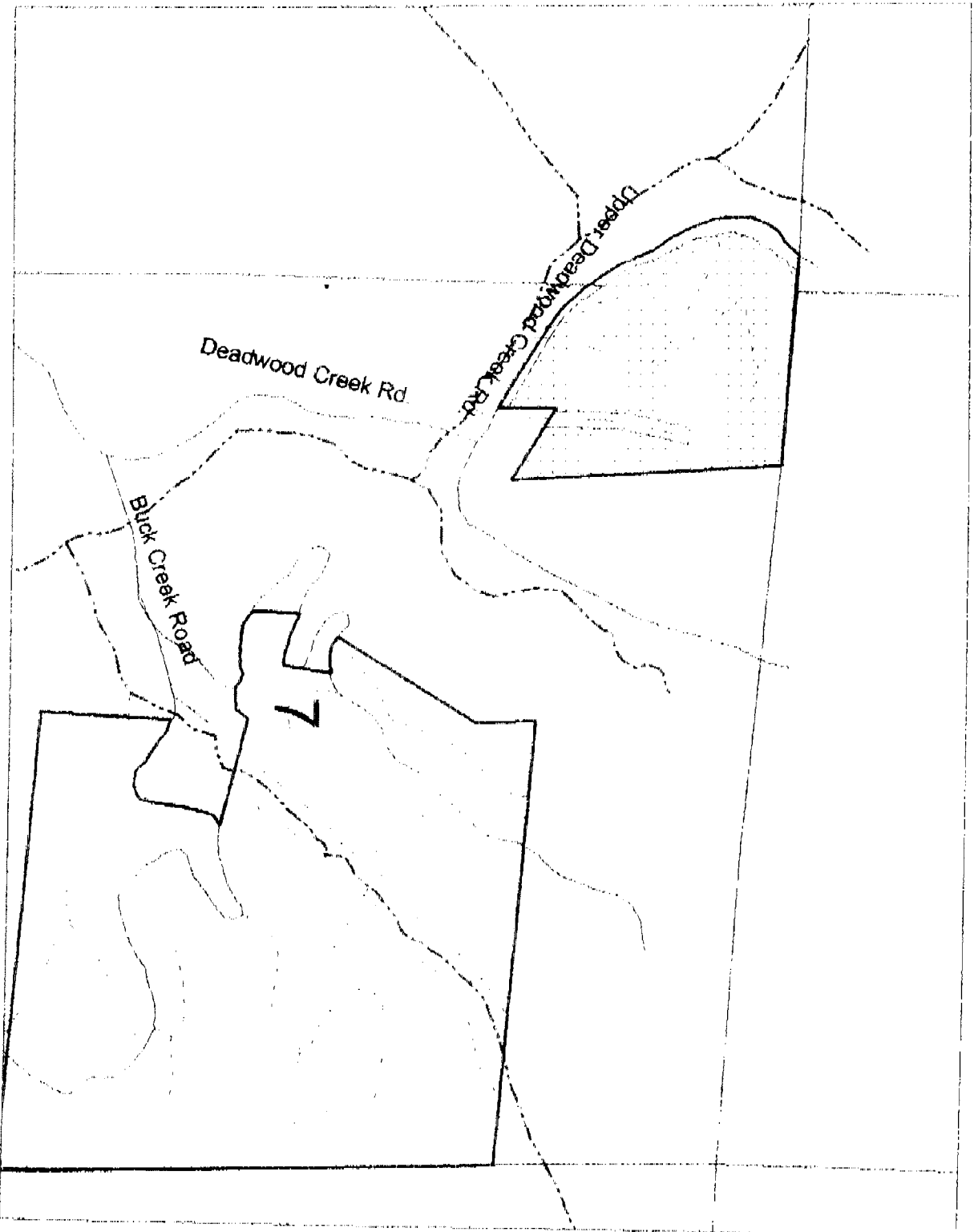

RE: Ground spray site prep units on Thompson Tree Farm property, Lane County.

We plan a back pack application to this unit to reduce competition to planting conifer species. Target species include grasses, forbes and rubus species. The operator will not apply chemical within 10 feet of aquatic areas of type F streams or D streams. Any other areas with surface water present will have a 10-foot buffer placed around the HWL.

Protection measures for resource:

1. A Thompson Timber Company representative will recon the unit prior to application to identify the resource being protected.
2. Herbicides will not be mixed or stored within 100 feet of waters of the state.
