An aerial herbicide application will be conducted to reduce seedling growth losses from vegetation competing with our seedlings for light, moisture and/or nutrients.


To protect type F and type D waterways, as well as areas of open water greater than 1/4 acre in size and significant wetlands, no direct application of chemicals will be made within 60 feet of those resources. Portions of RMAs left unharvested for stream protection will not be sprayed. Applications made adjacent to protected waterways will be flown parallel to the waterway when within 100 feet of the stream. If available, the half-boom spray technique will be used on the inside swath. The pilot will be briefed on the treatment of these areas through a combination of maps, aerial photos, and/or through a reconnaissance flight with a Swanson Group representative prior to application.

All batch activities will be conducted 100 feet or more from protected waterways.

To control spray drift, application will be done using coarse spray, a drift control additive, and/or straight stream nozzles, and only when wind velocities are low.

All chemical products will be applied in accordance with label directions.

This herbicide application will be done sometime between 3/13/07-3/31/07.
