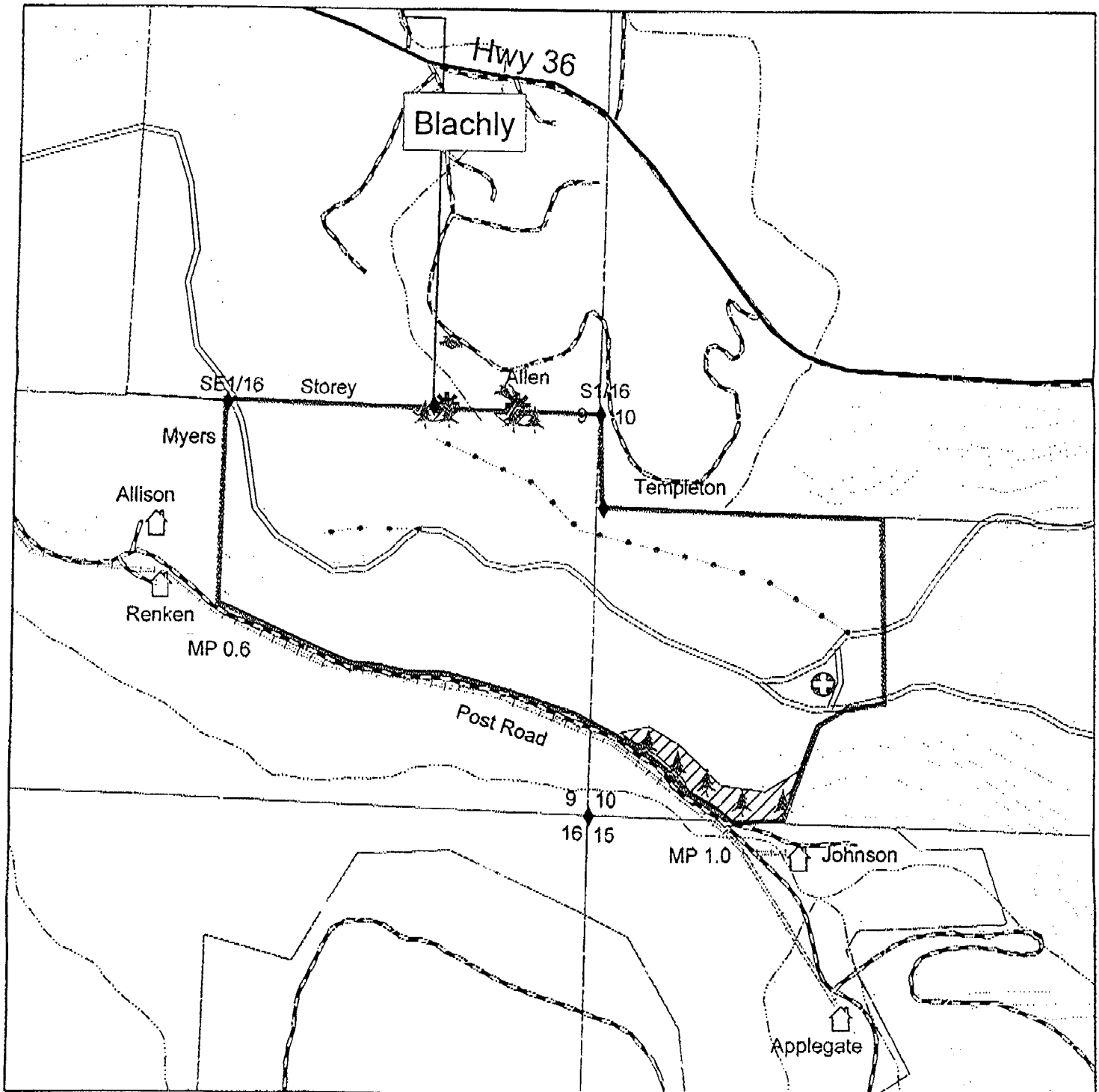

WRITTEN PLAN OF OPERATION

HARVEST UNIT: Post Road North
LOCATION: Sections 9,10, T16S, R7W, Lane County
NOTIFICATION: 2007-781-
DISCUSSION:

Final harvest activities are planned for approximately 46 acres as shown on the attached map.

A state-registered water source is located on the northern boundary of the harvest area. The point of collection is the head of a spring, with no overland flow or defined channel upslope of the collection point. No trees will be harvested within 20 feet of the collection point. An additional voluntary buffer has been marked around the spring area by designating some wildlife trees in the immediate area.

Felling will be done in a manner that minimizes damage to trees and vegetation retained in the buffer. Conifer trees within a tree length of the buffer will be felled parallel to, or away from the buffer. Because of safety concerns, hardwoods may be felled in the direction they lean. Hardwoods felled into the buffer will be bucked and yarded in a manner that minimizes additional disturbance to the buffer.

Machine piling of slash and brush may occur on slopes less than 40%. Ground disturbance will be minimized around the buffer and all machine activities with slash piling will be greater than 20 feet from the collection point. Slash accumulations will be piled away from trees retained in the buffer to minimize heat damage when they are burned.

High landslide hazard locations exist within the harvest areas, (slopes greater than 65% in headwalls and greater than 75% not in headwall areas.) No structures or paved public roads are located within the area of further review. For resource protection, when felling occurs in these areas trees will be felled parallel to the slope, and away from headwall areas where possible. Logs will be yarded with a minimum of one-end suspension to minimize soil disturbance in these areas.
