

#### Written Plan

**UNIT: 2007 Site Preparation Spray** 

LANDOWNER: Plum Creek

**OPERATOR:** Western Helicopter

**PLANNED OPERATION:** A spray operation is scheduled for the summer and fall of 2007 and will be completed by October 25<sup>th</sup> 2007. The spray is designed to reduce the competing vegetation in the plantation in order to allow the trees to reach green-up. The project will be completed using a helicopter and ground crew. Plum Creek will provide a representative to review and explain all portions of this plan to the operator before they begin work.

**TARGET VEGETATION:** Woody and herbaceous plants.

**PROTECTED RESOURCES:** See attached unit maps for protected streams and water systems.

The helicopter will not fly over any known active Strix occidentalis or Brachayramphus marmoratus Sites.

**PROTECTION MEASURES:** The following measures will be taken to protect all Fish, Domestic, Small, Medium and Large non-fish streams:

- Spray will not be directly applied to any small non-fish streams by helicopter or ground crews. A 60-foot buffer will be left unsprayed by the helicopter along Fish, Domestic, Medium and Large non-fish streams regardless of cutting boundaries. A 10-foot buffer will be left unsprayed by ground crews along all Fish, Domestic, Medium and Large streams regardless of cutting boundaries.
- 2. Operations will not be performed if wind direction or velocity is such that protected water resources are in danger of contamination.
- 3. All operations will be performed in accordance with the Oregon Forest Practices Act as they relate to the use and handling of chemicals.
