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

Protected resources covered by this written plan include: 1) an unclassified, unnamed tributary of Doak Creek in Section 18, 2) Preacher Creek (Small F), and 3) an unnamed tributary of Fox Hollow Creek (Small F) in Section 1.

Resource protection measures planned are as follows:

- 1) All mixing and batching operations shall be conducted at sites over 100 feet from any fish bearing stream.
- 2) No chemical application shall take place within 10 feet of the aquatic area of the Fish stream.
- 3) All application shall be done in accordance with product label requirements.
- 4) Water for chemical mixing may be taken from the Small or Medium Fish streams. This activity shall be conducted in accordance with water quality protection rules of the Forest Practices Act. A separate volume pump and system used for water only shall be used to fill the batch tanks. An air gap between the water source and mixing tank shall be maintained during the filling process.
