Re: Written Plan for 2010 Operations

Seneca Jones Timber Company herein submits a written plan for operations near a resource protection area. In accordance with the Oregon Forest Practices Act, these operations shall provide equal or better protection for the environment while enhancing effectiveness of forest management operations and achievement of the desired future condition. This written plan is based on the following information:

Type of Operation:	Aerial Herbicide Application		
Unit:	<u>South Camus 4</u>	<u>T20S, R4W, Section 04</u>	<u>34 acres</u>
Reason for Plan:	Operation within 100' of type 'F' class stream		

Information:

Barlow Creek flows on the north side of our herbicide application unit. This specific resource protection area is identified on the attached map as well as the stream classification of a medium fish. This stream is classed as a medium, 'F' or fish-bearing stream, in this area. Seneca plans to directly apply herbicides adjacent to the indicated watercourse but no closer than 60 feet. Residual hardwoods and conifers exist along the stream bank. This will allow the buffer to protect the stream from any potential drift or error of application and maintain shade on the watercourse. This herbicide operation will utilize herbicides primarily for control of herbaceous vegetation and hardwood sprouts.

The protection of this stream zone will be ensured by Seneca's continued dedication to the proper application of herbicides through the following practices. The on-site Seneca representative will perform a pre-application reconnaissance flight to delineate unit boundaries and resource protection areas with applicator, and to establish a final application plan in accordance with the Oregon Forest Practices Act and EPA Pesticide Label directions and precautions. Considering specific weather and unit conditions at the time of application, this plan may include, but not be limited to: the utilization of appropriate nozzle size and orientation; modifications to application system and boom length, or half boom applications; and continuous weather monitoring to assess risk and continued plan success. These stream zone protection measures are consistent with best management practices and will not affect any of the existing required components of the riparian management zone.

In closing we believe these measures will benefit both the environment and the operations of Seneca Jones Timber Company. Otherwise, we will anticipate your approval of this measure and proceed as indicated during our operations.
