Notice is given to the State Forester that an operation will be conducted on the lands described herein.

SF Comments: Manually treating individual hardwoods by hacking into each stem and inject a solution 50% Polaris A.C. 50% water. Those clumps smaller than 4 feet in size can be foliar treated with a 10% Chopper.






Simonson East 89 Acres Hack-n-Squirt





Re: Written Plan for 2010 Operations

Seneca Jones Timber Company herein submits a written plan for operations near a resource protection area. These operations shall provide equal or better protection for the environment than the Oregon Forest Practices Act, while enhancing the effectiveness of forest management operations and the achievement of the desired future condition of the plantation. This written plan is based on the following information:

Type of Operation:

Manual Herbicide Application

Unit:

South Camus 2005 T20S, R4W, Section 02 acres

Reason for Plan:

Operation within 100' of type 'F' class stream

Information:

A tributary to Hawley Creek flows through the northern portion of Seneca's herbicide application unit. Residual conifers and hardwoods exist along the stream edge. This specific resource protection area is identified on the attached map. This stream is classed as small, 'F' or fish-bearing stream, in this area. Seneca plans to apply herbicides adjacent to but no closer than 10 feet to the indicated watercourses, allowing this buffer to protect the stream from any error of application and maintain shade on the watercourse. This release operation will utilize an Arsenal herbicide primarily for control of hardwood vegetation.

The protection of these stream zones will be ensured by Seneca's continued dedication to the proper application of herbicides through the following practices. Prior to application a Seneca representative will relay the information included in this written plan to the applicator. This information will include a thorough review of the stream zones and the 10' no hack buffer zone as well as property line locations. Applicator will be instructed to utilize a batching area at least 100 feet from any water area. Prior to and during the application period the applicator will take continuous weather measurements to assess risk and continued plan success. These stream zone protection measures are consistent with best management practices and will not affect any of the required components of the riparian management zone.

In closing we believe these measures will benefit both the environment and the operations of Seneca Jones Timber Company. Otherwise, we will anticipate your approval of this measure and proceed as indicated during our operations.
