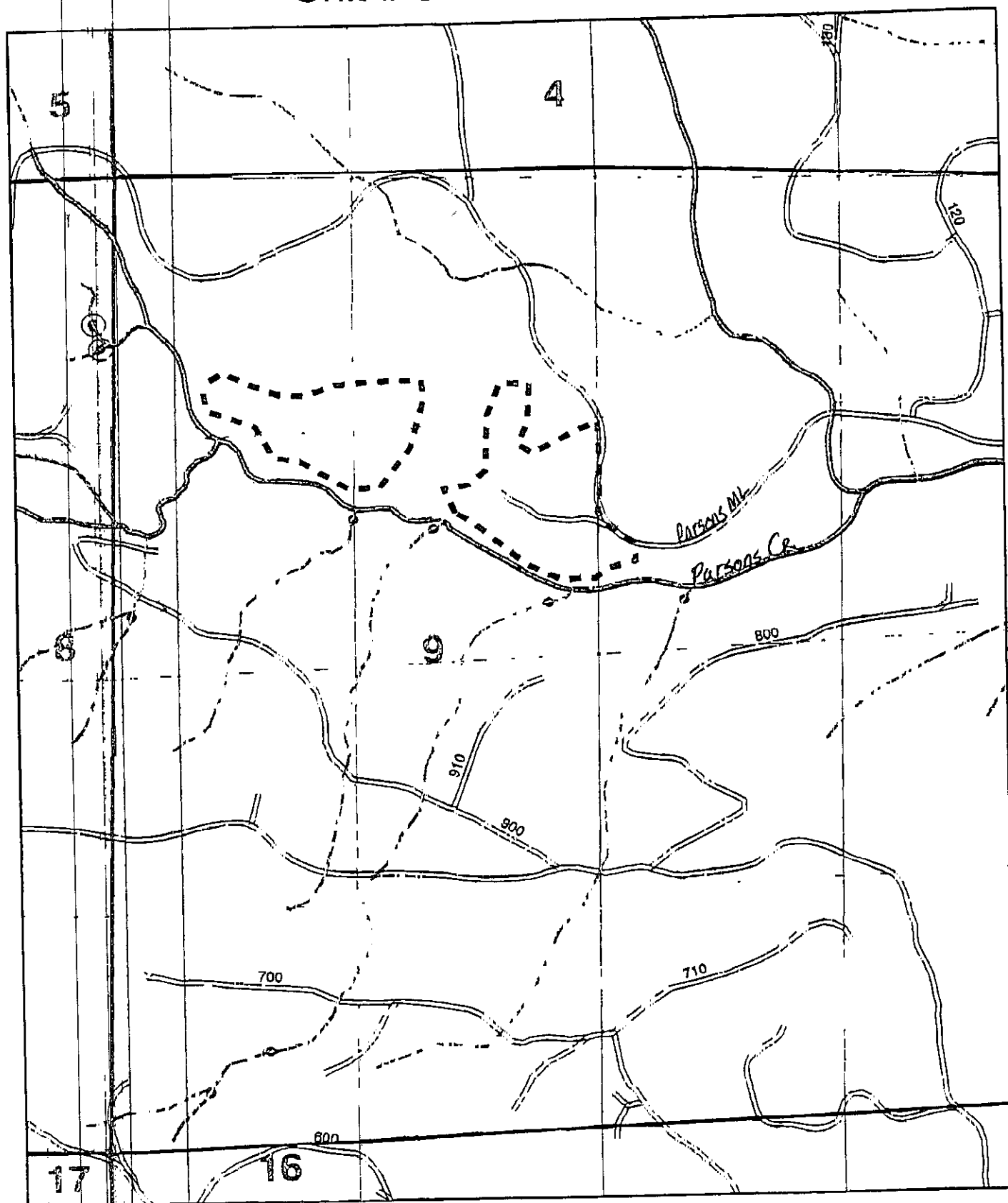

All vegetation required to be protected by the water protection rules within the riparian management areas will be protected. No vegetation will be treated within buffer strips left during logging.
