WRITTEN PLAN OF OPERATION FOR GROUND HERBICIDE APPLICATION

Weyerhaeuser Company is planning Ground spot/ broadcast spray applications targeting broadleaf and/or herbaceous vegetation near protected resources. This letter is our submission of a written plan of operation for activities within 100 feet of protected resources. The plat submitted with the ODF notification shows the unit boundaries and resources to be protected.

No herbicide will be directly applied within 10 feet of the high water mark of any protected resource defined as F or D stream, lakes, significant wetlands and other areas of standing open water greater than one-quarter acre at the time of application. No treatment of existing streamside buffer strips from previous harvest activities will be done. All application will be done in compliance with the Oregon Forest Practices Rules and label instructions.

Landowner will identify the above-protected resources with crew foreman prior to application by means of aerial photos, maps and/or ground visits to provide operator with adequate information to properly treat the area.


