I am writing this letter to help answer any questions you may have in regards to the attached notification of operations. As the notification shows I intend to perform a site release spray application on the subject property.

We will not be spraying or mixing chemicals within 100' of any water on this property. We will maintain a minimum 10' buffer along any small non-fish creeks within our unit. We will also install a minimum 60' no spray buffer along any type F, or D streams within my unit. Special care will be taken to keep products out of the water.

Products to be applied may include SFM (Oust or Spyder), and Hexazinone (Velpar DF).

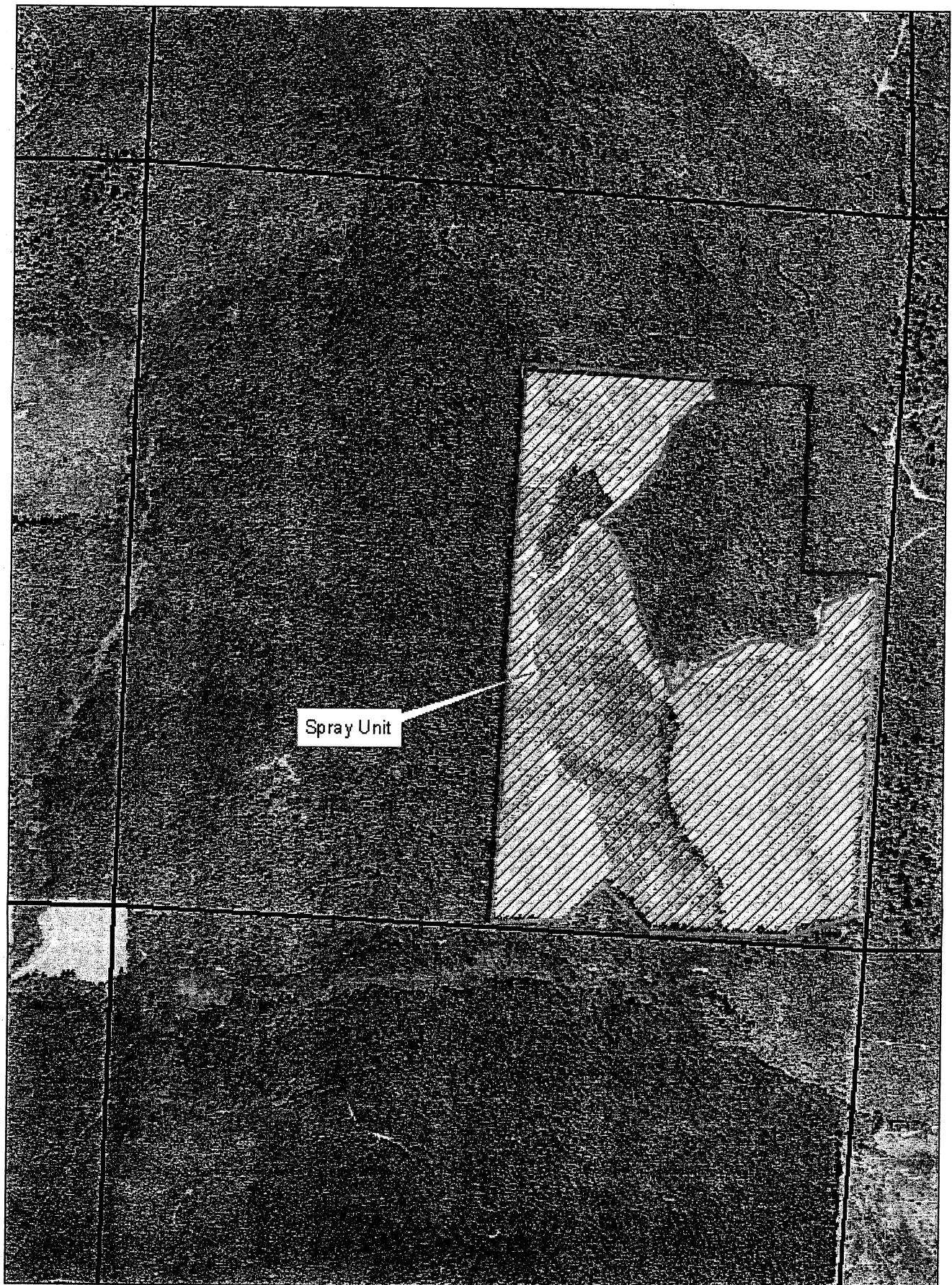
