Kingzett Notification of Operation – Additional Project Detail

Project Overview

Kingzett is purchasing the subject property and as outlined in the purchase agreement, has authority to start reforestation activities. The tract was harvested under previous ownership and reforestation activities on portions of the tract do not meet ODF guidelines for reforestation. See Bob Johnson for details.

Slash Pile Burning

Slash from previous harvest operation is located as show on the project aerial photo. Kingzett will burn piles only during fire season and will coordinate with ODF. The approximate size of each pile is 20'x25'x7'.

Chemical Treatment

Treatment of Maple Clumps will be done by identified contractor using mostly Hack & Squirt technique. Some foliar treatment might be used on smaller clumps. The tract also has significant presence of Scotch Broom and blackberry which will be treated to allow release of seedlings. Some site prep may be conducted to allow for additional seedling planting in the winter of 2012-2013. All chemical treatments will be ground based.
