Re: Written Plan for 2013 operations

Seneca Jones Timber Company herein submits a written plan for operations near a resource protection area. In accordance with the Oregon Forest Practices Act, these operations shall provide equal or better protection for the environment while enhancing effectiveness of forest management operations and achievement of the desired future condition. This written plan is based on the following information:

Type of Operation:

Reason for Plan:

Manual Herbicide Application

Unit:

<u>Fish Flat T16S, R7W, Section 30</u> <u>9 Acres</u> Operation within 100' of type 'F' class stream

Information:

Lake Creek flows within 100 feet of Seneca's Herbicide-Brush operation area. This stream is classed as large 'F' or fish-bearing stream, in this area. Seneca plans to apply herbicides only in the treatment area shown on the attached map, but no closer than 10 feet of the high water mark. This will allow the buffer to protect the streams from any potential drift or error of application and maintain shade on the watercourse. This release operation will utilize Triclopyr, Glyphosate, Syltac and Surfactant Oil herbicides primarily for control of Scotch Broom and Black Berry.

The protection of these stream zones will be ensured by Seneca's continued dedication to the proper application of herbicides through the following practices. Prior to application a Seneca representative will relay the information included in this written plan to the applicator. This information will include a thorough review of the stream zone and the 10' no spray buffer zone as well as property line locations. Applicator will be instructed to utilize a batching area at least 100 feet from any water area. Prior to and during the application period the applicator will take continuous weather measurements to assess risk and continued plan success. These stream zone protection measures are consistent with best management practices and will not affect any of the required components of the riparian management zone.

In closing we believe these measures will benefit both the environment and the operations of Seneca Jones Timber Company. If there are any concerns or more appropriate measures to be considered, please telephone our office at 541.461-6245. Otherwise, we will anticipate your approval of this measure and proceed as indicated during our operations.




