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The following is a written plan for slash burning and fire trail construction within 100 feet of type F streams. This written plan is for "7H" in sections 11 and 12(19S-08W), and "Black Panther" in section 20 (20S-06W).

Measures which will protect the riparian management areas:

No standing RMA trees will be cut for fire trail construction.

The day of ignition will be determined by in-coming weather patterns that will assist mop-up activities and reduce threat to protected resources.

The fire will be "backed down" into the edge of the RMA. Backing the fire down will reduce the chance of radiant heat killing trees inside the RMA.

Fuel moisture differentials between the existing buffer strip and the harvest unit will be monitored and utilized to prevent/minimize burning within the buffer strip. Where inadequate moisture differentials exist, hand fire trail will be constructed.

Fire intensity will be minimized (via a moisture differential) to reduce the chance of erosion.

Saws and torches will not be fueled within 100 feet of any open water.
