Notice to Landowner(s)

Notice to Timber Owner

If timber harvesting is part of the proposed operations, the party shown above, owning the timber at the point it is first measured is responsible for payment of Oregon timber taxes.

Notice to Operator(s)

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If you are conducting timber harvesting or road construction within 100 feet of overhead utility lines contact the local utility in accordance with ORS 757.805 - Oregon's Overhead Safety Act and OAR 437-007-0230 - Power Line Safeguards. Identification tags are located on each pole.

Call the Oregon Utility Notification Center at 811 at least 2 business days before starting timber harvesting, road construction, or any other activities involving excavation that may affect an underground utility line. The Center will coordinate with the appropriate utility companies to locate underground utility lines that may be affected by your activities.




