In accordance with the administrative rules of the Oregon Forest Practices Act, this letter constitutes the written plan for operations near the protected resource(s) identified below:

Operation Name/Activity: "Lake Creek 5 H&S" - Manual Application

Notification Number: Not Yet Assigned

Legal Location: T.17S R.8W Sec. 7 & 8

Protected Resource(s): Chappell Creek (Med type F) and tributary (Sm type F)

In an effort to control competing vegetation and promote conifer plantation growth, Rosboro intends to treat various species (namely big leaf maple). This will be a ground-based "hack and squirt" operation.

Treatment will likely occur within 100 feet of Chappell Creek and the associated tributary that borders the southern edge of the operation, but will stay outside of the overstory retention area associated with the respective RMAs. Chemicals will be applied in accordance with respective product labels and will not be stored, mixed or batched within 100 feet of the noted waters.

The contents of this written plan are expected to comply with the requirements for the operation adjacent to the disclosed protected resources, and the protection measures described herein are believed to achieve the objectives of the Forest Practices Act.
