Comment from: David Kjosness 12/17/2014

Per e-mailed request from Brian Aurdahl on 12/16/14, this notification is continued into 2015 and should be considered a 2015 notification.

Comment from: Jay Morey 12/18/2014

Office Resource Review for units located in T21S, R8W, Sections 22, 26, 31, 32, and 36. No concerns noted at this time.

Comment from: Delos Devine 12/19/2014

In the future please submit a separate notification for units within Coos District (unless the unit boundary lapses more than one District line). The written plan does not adequately identify protected streams. I did receive new maps via email which adequately identify the protected stream area. I am waiving the waiting period for operations greater than 100 feet from the Vincent Creek tributary (Coos District).

Comment from: Delos Devine 12/23/2014

I have reviewed the written plan and fish stream protection maps (see documents) for the Fall Switchback and Fall Vincent Thinned units. The written plan is adequate (with maps). The waiting period ends after 12/31/2014 for these two units.

Comment from: Dan Menk 12/23/2014

Maps (Devil 22, Devil 22 NE, Argue Creek, and Argue South) were emailed to western Lane District on 12/19/14 that showed the protected streams. The label for Rozol states that it may not be applied from mid May to September 1.

Comment from: Jay Morey 1/2/2015

Written Plan comments submitted for units located in T21S, R8W, Sections 22, 26, 31, 32, and 36.

Comment from: Dan Menk 1/8/2015

This is regarding your Statutory Written Plan required by :

- ORS 527. 670(3)(a) and OAR 629-605-0170(1)(a) for an operation within 100 feet of a Type F or Type D stream.

After reviewing your written plan, I offer you the following comments.

- Fully implementing this written plan is likely to achieve the resource protection standards. This operation will be evaluated on the basis of how well required practices are applied and how well required resource protection is achieved.

**Notice to Landowner(s)**

Reforestation may be required by the landowner if timber harvesting is part of the proposed operations.

On-site inspections may be conducted by Oregon Department of Forestry employees to ensure compliance with all laws and rules governing fire protection and forest practices on private land.

Land use conversion to non-forest use involves regulations administered by other state and local governments, which may apply to the future use or development of this site.

**Notice to Operator(s)**

If you are conducting timber harvesting or road construction within 100 feet of overhead utility lines contact the local utility in accordance with ORS 757.805 - Oregon's Overhead Safety Act and OAR 437-007-0230 - Power Line Safeguards. Identification tags are located on each pole.

Call the Oregon Utility Notification Center at 811 at least 2 business days before starting timber harvesting, road construction, or any other activities involving excavation that may affect an underground utility line. The Center will coordinate with the appropriate utility companies to locate underground utility lines that may be affected by your activities.
